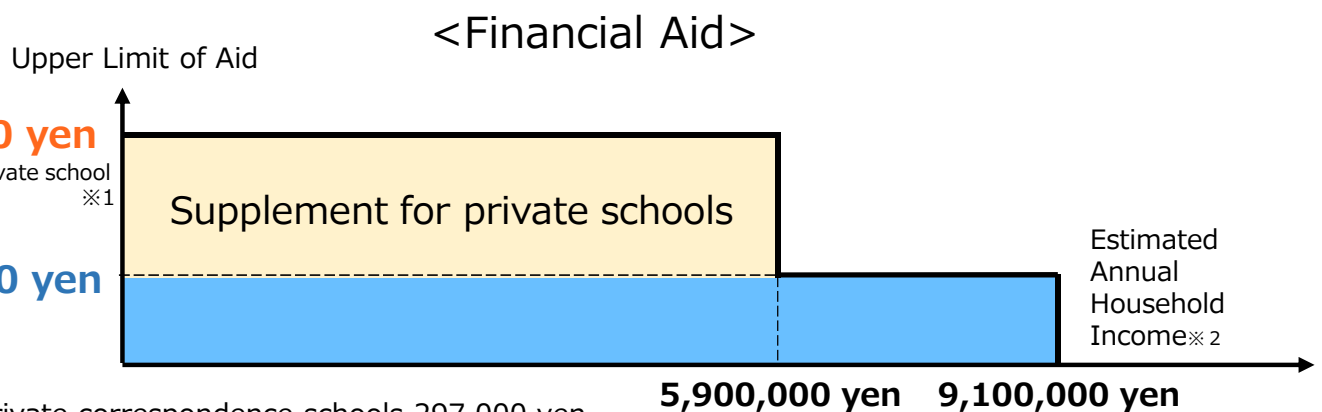
Financial Aid for Those Entering High School

Tuition support with NO repayment is available

For those who have a Japanese address and fulfill the criteria (described on the back)



*Eligible schools: high schools, special educational needs schools (HS level), technical colleges (1st-3rd year), vocational schools (HS level), etc.



※ 1 For private correspondence schools 297,000 yen
For public technical colleges (1st-3rd year) 234,600 yen

※ 2 Estimate based on a family of four with one working parent, one child in high school, and one child in middle school (See table on back for estimated annual income by family composition)

※ Depending on the school, the tuition fee may be collected while the grant amount is being decided and then refunded at a later date. If this causes financial hardship, it may be possible to postpone payment. Please ask your school for details.

How to Apply

(For new students)

The school will inform you when procedures must be completed, such as **during enrollment in April**. Please be sure to confirm this with your school.

(For current students)

The school will inform you **by the time a report of income is needed around July**.

※Generally, the application is **online**. Application procedures are simpler with **"My Number"**.
(Each prefecture's application process may vary, so please follow your school's instructions)

Criteria for Eligibility

Using the following formula (Total income of parents)

【Formula】

Municipal Tax Base × 6% – Municipal Adjusted Tax Deduction

※ For ordinance-designated cities, calculate after multiplying adjusted tax deduction by ¾.

※ If there is a change in tax base or adjusted tax deduction after filing your revised income tax return, or if there is a change in guardian due to divorce or death, it may result in a change of eligibility or grant amount, or possibly require financial aid be returned. In such cases, you must quickly submit a report of income to the prefecture through your school (For national high schools, to MEXT through your school).

※Middle school is considered 15 years old and younger, high school is 16-18 years old, and university is 19-22 years old.

※Assumes no other income besides salary, and that if both parents are working, their salary is equal.

Financial Emergency Support System

This system aids households who have lost income due to reasons such as injury/illness of parents making them unable to work or loss of a job from factors outside of their control. In the case of a sudden unexpected reduction in household income, quickly consult with your school and apply.

Main Requirements

Qualifying as having sudden unexpected reduction in income

Yearly household income falling below about 5,900,000 yen

Monthly: 33,000 yen
